SUBJECT: Amendment of Mayor's Order 93-148, dated September 29, 1993 and
Reappointments and Appointments - District of Columbia Statewide Independent
Living Council

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Code § 1-242(2)(1999 Repl.), and in accordance with Mayor's Order 93-148, dated September 29, 1993, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Section I and II of Mayor's Order 93-148, dated September 29, 1993 is amended to read as follows:

I. ESTABLISHMENT

There is hereby established in the Government of the District of Columbia a Statewide Independent Living Council (hereinafter referred to as the "Council").

II PURPOSE


The Council shall collaborate with the Rehabilitation Services Administration of the District of Columbia Department of Human Services to assure participation of District citizens with disabilities in the planning and development of vocational rehabilitation and independent living services.

2. **JORGE PINEDA** is reappointed as a member of the Council for a term to end November 3, 2002.
3. **PHYLLIS WINSTON** is reappointed as a member of the Council for a term to end November 3, 2001.
4. The following persons are appointed as members of the Council for terms to end November 3, 2003:



7. **DARNISE HENRY BUSH** is appointed as an ex-officio member of the Council, representing the Mayor's Committee on Persons with Disabilities and shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.
